STUDENT RESEARCH AWARD

The Louisiana Mosquito Control Association has established an award program for students conducting research in any area of mosquito biology or control. **May 15th is the application deadline** for this research award.

Guidelines for eligibility and application are listed below:

- All undergraduate and graduate students enrolled in public or private schools in the State of Louisiana are eligible to apply.
- The student must be the principal person responsible for collecting and analyzing data.
- The research subject must involve some aspect of mosquito biology or control.
- The student must submit a written description of the research plan (not to exceed a cover page and 10 double spaced typed pages). This is to include a brief overview of the relevance of the project, the methods used and the significance of the expected results. The cover page should include the title of the project and the student's name, address and phone number.
- The research plan will be evaluated by the LMCA Research Committee for originality, clarity, organization and significance.
- The winner will be awarded \$500 to be used for research or associated educational costs. The winner is expected to attend the next LMCA Annual Meeting to present the results of the research project. The LMCA will provide up to an additional \$200 for expenses associated with travel to the meeting.
