OPERATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

- That the LMCA establish an award for the best operational paper presented at the LMCA Annual Meeting.
- The award shall be limited to one (1) per year.
- That the award be given only when warranted by the quality of work, with the decision to be made by the Awards Committee.
- That the award be made to persons who are residents of the State of Louisiana and employed by a mosquito control operation in Louisiana.
- That the award be given for contributions of an operational nature. Examples:
 - Employee education programs
 - Improved safety procedures
 - Improved maintenance procedures
 - Implementation of public education programs
 - Improved record-keeping procedures
 - Improved collection devices
 - Construction of new or improved equipment, etc.
 - Improved surveillance techniques
 - Improved application techniques
- That the award consists of a plaque engraved with the recipient's name, date of the award and area of achievement.
- That the LMCA President notify the recipient's supervisor of the award and express the LMCA's appreciation for the supervisor(s)' support of the recipient and goals of the LMCA.
- That the LMCA Awards Committee notifies the news media in the recipient's area, concerning the award.
- All potential candidates for the award shall submit a written summary detailing the work and outlining the paper to be presented at the LMCA meeting. All submissions must be received thirty (30) days prior to the annual meeting.
- The Awards Committee shall have full and total authority to establish and administer the award.
- Judging of applicants will not commence until after the Annual Meeting with a decision reached by the first BOD meeting after the LMCA Annual Meeting. Announcement of the recipient will be included in the first LMCA *Newsletter* and at the LMCA Spring Workshop. Presentation of the award will be made at the next LMCA Annual Meeting.
- In the solicitation, reviewing and awarding of an award to the applicants, no applicant will be discriminated against because of sex, religion, race, color or national origin.
